The undersigned, (hereinafter "Applicant") hereby applies for membership in, and agrees to purchase electric energy from Heartland Power Cooperative (hereinafter "Cooperative"), upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Applicant shall, when electric energy becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the premises described below, and will pay therefore monthly at rates which will be fixed by the Board of Directors of the Cooperative. The Applicant will pay not less than the minimum charge for electric service which may from time to time be fixed by the Board of Directors, regardless of the number of kilowatt hours consumed
2. The Applicant's premises shall be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by the Current National Electrical Safety Code and the Cooperative. All service lines, meters, switches and other materials and appliances constructed or installed by the Cooperative, except so much thereof as shall be purchased by the Applicant, shall remain the property of the Cooperative, and the cooperative shall have the right and privilege to enter upon Applicant's premises to repair, service, and, upon discontinuance of service, to remove the same.
3. The Applicant saves and holds the Cooperative harmless from any damages arising from any causes on the Applicant's side of the service meter.
4. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the Cooperative, and such rules and regulations as may, from time to time, be adopted by the Cooperative.
5. The Applicant hereby grants the Cooperative an easement for all right-of-way which may reasonably be necessary for the Cooperative to construct, operate, and maintain facilities to provide service to the Applicant.
